

New Information Kiosk at Oakwood Cemetery October 16, 2005

The new information kiosk at Oakwood Cemetery will soon provide a source of information to the public when the office is closed. A locking display case was obtained from the airport division, removed from an old Air Force office building. This display case will hold site information along with current / future activities. The Green area to the right will have three clear plastic holders:

- One to distribute historic walking tour booklets.
- One to house guest registration cards.
- One to house 8 ½ X 11 maps of the site

If the attendant is away from the office during the week, a guest looking for a gravesite could call the main office and get a location over the phone. The 8 ½ x 11 map will have instructions on the back on how to use the larger kiosk map on the back side to find a gravesite. On the weekend information is available at the Austin History Center. Directions to the History Center will be provided.



Dimensions are
Height to roof drip edge 6' 6"
Ground to bottom edge 2' 6"
Locking display case – 4' high, 6' long, 3" deep
Green area to the right – 2' wide, 4' tall

This area will hold a site map of Oakwood and Oakwood Annex

Each map will be laminated individually then place on the display area with dbl sided tape.

A sheet of Plexiglas will then cover both maps and prevent theft. This area will be shaded from the sun so fading will be at a minimum.
